Sl. No.	GENERAL CONDITIONS
1.	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 25 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2.	Compliance of the points no. 1 to 10 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.
Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 25 of which not more than 8 of the total sections running may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of land and class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension
2	The school is directed to run atleast 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III in accordance with established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
3	As per office records and OASIS, the school land area is 2633 sq mtrs, however, in the online application school has filled the land area as 3520 and submit the land certificate accordingly. Hence, the school has increase the land area from 2633 sq mtrs to 3520 sq mtrs. Thus, the school is directed to remit an amount of R. 75,000 in favour of Customer Name: Secretary CBSE, A/c no.: 50100023037695, IFSC Code: HDFC0000120, Swift Code: HDFCINBB, Branch Name : Vikas Marg, City: Delhi, as the fee of "Increase in land area" and submit the documentary evidence in compliance within 03 months.

4	The school is required to appoint qualified staff for the science subjects as well as upgrade the library with adequate number of books (science subjects) and submit the compliance within 03 months
5	The school is required to (i) remove the gas connection and washbasins from the workstation of physics lab (ii) shift the mathematics lab in bigger room with minimum size of 48 sqm (iii) set-up composite science lab in light of Board's SoP and submit the videographic compliance within 03 months.
6	The library is under sized and it does not have separate reading space for staff. Further, there are benches are being used for seating in place of proper seating arrangement. Thus, the school is required to upgrade the library in light of Board's SoP and submit the videographic compliance within 03 months
7	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance
8	The school is directed to pay the salary to its staff as per Central / State Govt. Norms through ECS mode only and submit the revised salary statement of its staff with their name & designation in compliance within 03 months.
9	The school is directed to ensure that all essential valid documents are available under the head Mandatory Public Disclosure (as per annexure – IX) on school's website at all time and the link of certificates should be remain functional and submit an undertaking in this regard on its letter head duly signed by the principal and manager of the school in the compliance within 03 months.
10	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Delhi West within 03 months and submit the compliance.

The above is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions or as may be laid down by the Board from time to time:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students and renew all safety certificate as and when due.
